## **Press Release**

In view of the recent developments in Afghanistan, the Government of India has introduced a separate sub-category of **e-Emergency X-Misc. Visa** to Afghan nationals desirous of travelling to India and all physical visas issued to Afghan nationals are now **invalid / cancelled.** 

Afghan nationals are hereby advised to apply for 'e-Emergency X-Misc. Visa' on the e-Visa portal at <a href="https://indianvisaonline.gov.in">https://indianvisaonline.gov.in</a>. The documents required are: (i) Passport (compulsory) (ii) National Identity Card (Tazkira) of Afghanistan (compulsory) (iii) any proof of residence in Afghanistan (optional) and (iv) any proof of employment/occupation in Afghanistan (optional). Only Afghan nationals holding Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) for e-Emergency X-Misc visa issued by the Bureau of Immigration will be allowed to board India-bound flights. However, in respect of Afghan nationals granted Long Term Visa (LTV) in India and who had gone to Afghanistan/any other country on the basis of Return Visa granted by FRROs/FROs and are stranded there may return to India on the basis of the LTV and Return visa.

Afghan nationals coming on e-Emergency X-Misc. Visa will have to mandatorily register with the FRRO/FRO concerned within 7 days of arrival in India. If they are moving from their registered place of stay to another place, they will have to further register mandatorily with the FRRO/FRO concerned at the new place of residence.
